4.1 UPDATE AND UPGRADE PROCEDURES

Update of an Existing MTL 5.0 Installation No further preparations are required. The settings are retained. Unpack the ZIP archive and execute the correct installation package (.msi file) for your operating system (32 or 64-bit).

Upgrade of MTL 4.0 to Version 5.0

When upgrading an existing MTL 4.0 installation, all settings are transferred to MTL 5.0 as far as possible.

A new license is required for MTL 5.0. Upgrade licenses of MTL 4.0 are also available.

Licensing doesn't distinguish between MTL packages for the different Mitel CSs any longer, and a license can be used for any of the Mitel CSs.
